

Update on the Global Grant 1987474. Lodi Rotary and the Downtown Batangas club, Philippines have received approval of the grant from Rotary Internattional. The grant is in process of being funded and it is anticipated that the Ultrasound machine will be purchased in March 2020. Below is an interview conducted by Dr. Julie Damron-Brown with George Edd-Bennett our newest member.



Greetings fellow Rotarians, I am your newest member, George Edd-Bennett, and I am excited to be counted among you as people committed to doing what benefits all concerned in the community of Lodi, CA and in the world at large. As a pastor in the United Methodist Church, I believe that faith is life and life is faith.
