# **FOUNDATION MEMBERS**

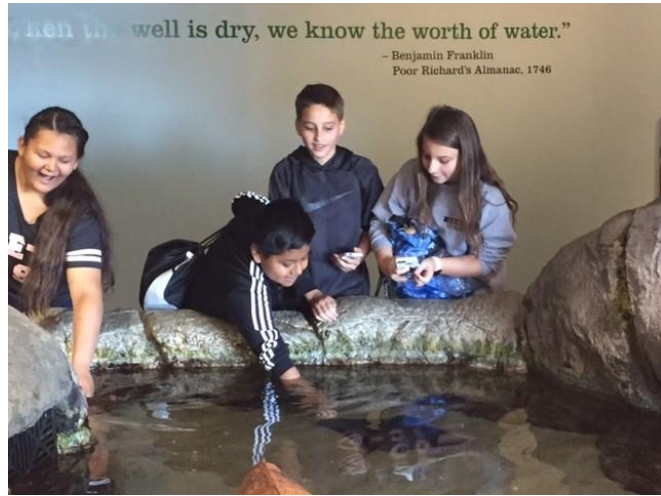
The Board of Directors is comprised of volunteers with all donations and event sponsorships going directly to programs and services for children.
